BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure.

First Reading — Before anything was created, the wisdom of God was brought forth (Proverbs 8:22-31).

Psalm — O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth! (Psalm 8).

Second Reading — God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us (Romans 5:1-5).

Gospel — Everything that the Father has is mine; the Spirit will take from what is mine and declare it to you (John 16:12-15).

Review boating safety measures before going on family vacation

If your family is planning a beach or lake vacation, it is time to review a few simple boating safety measures. Discuss these rules with your family before you go out on the water so everyone knows what is expected. Everyone should wear life jackets that fit them safely. Children should also be monitored for any signs of hypothermia, especially after playing in the water. Keep dry blankets, towels, and extra clothes on hand to change into if children are too cold. Los padres de familia deben aprender o refrescar las habilidades básicas de resucitación cardiopulmonar y rescate acuático antes de las vacaciones. 

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today is the feast day of the Most Holy Trinity. The biblical roots of our understanding of God as three distinct Persons united in one God can be seen in Matthew 4:13-17. After Jesus was baptized by John in the Jordan River, and when he came up from the water, an image of the Trinity can be seen in the coming of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus and the voice of God the Father saying, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.” Also, in Matthew 28:19, the resurrected Jesus sends out his apostles into the world to “make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”

The concept of the Trinity is not something we human beings could ever have fully come up with based only on human reasoning, nor is this mystery something we can ever claim to fully understand. It was to the people of Israel that God revealed that there is only one God and not a multitude of gods as other ancient nations believed at that time. Then, with the coming of Jesus, we learned that besides God the Father there is also God the Son. Finally, with the coming of the Holy Spirit, the third divine Person, we now have the full picture of God.

Here at St. Pancratius, for the last 10 months, we’ve been enjoying a kind of “trinity” of persons in our rectory, consisting of Fr. Andrew, myself, and our seminarian intern, Jaime Arriaga. We are about to lose 1/3 of this little trinity as Jaime will now be “ascending” back to the seminary in Camarillo for two more years of study in preparation for the priesthood. May the Holy Trinity be his guide and protector as he continues to respond to the calling of God.

Queridos hermanas y hermanos en Cristo,

Hoy es la fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad. Las raíces bíblicas de nuestra comprensión de Dios como tres Personas distintas unidas en un solo Dios se pueden ver en Mateo 4:13-17. Después de que Jesús fue bautizado por Juan en el río Jordán, y cuando salió del agua, se puede ver una imagen de la Trinidad en la venida del Espíritu Santo sobre Jesús y la voz de Dios Padre que dice, “Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia.” También, en Mateo 28:19, Jesús resucitado envía a sus apóstoles al mundo para “hacer discípulos a todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo.”

El concepto de la Trinidad no es algo que nosotros, los seres humanos, podríamos haber inventado completamente basados solo en el razonamiento humano, ni es este misterio algo que podamos afirmar que entendemos completamente. Fue al pueblo de Israel a quien Dios le reveló que hay un solo Dios y no una multitud de dioses como otras naciones antiguas creían que había en aquellos tiempos. Luego, con la venida de Jesús, aprendimos que además de Dios Padre también está Dios Hijo. Finalmente, con la venida del Espíritu Santo, la tercera Persona divina, ahora tenemos la imagen completa de Dios.

Aquí en San Pancracio, durante los últimos 10 meses, hemos disfrutado de un tipo de una “Trinidad” de personas en nuestra rectoría, compuesta por el P. Andrés, yo y nuestro seminarista interno, Jaime Arriaga. Estamos a punto de perder una tercera parte de esta pequeña trinidad ya que Jaime ahora “ascenderá” de regreso a seminario en Camarillo para dos años más de estudio en preparación para el sacerdocio. Que la Santísima Trinidad sea su guía y protectora mientras continúa respondiendo al llamado de Dios.


