

### THE GIFT OF FAITH

Failh is a gift. When the disciples asked desus to increase their failh, they were going to the source of that failh with their request. God is the giver of all good gifts, including failh. When we put our failh in Christ, we believe that God is with us, even though we cannot physically see God. Or can we? If we are attentive, we see the evidence of God's presence in the love of family and friends, care poured out in service of our neighbors, the living beauty of creation. This is not blind failh, but rather is the result of seeing with the eyes of failh. Followers of Jesus look beyond what is apparent to see what is possible with the power and presence of the Holy Spirit within and among us.
