

Summer and water safety at home While parents are often hyper vigilant around pools and lakes, drowning can happen at home in an instant, especially with very young children. This summer, watch children around water at home, including buckets, containers, and kiddie pools. Children can drown in as little as an inch of water, so constant supervision is necessary. Dear St. Pancratius Family,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. These are two great pillars of our Church. Much can be said about them. For today, I thought I would share an excerpt from one of St. Peter's successors, Pope St. John Paul II. From his homily on this Solemnity in 1999:

"Blessed is the Lord who delivers his friends" (Response, Responsorial Psalm; Italian Lectionary). In their apostolic mission, Sts Peter and Paul were obliged to face difficulties of every kind. But, far from deterring their missionary activity, these difficulties reinforced their zeal for the Church's welfare and for the salvation of mankind. They were able to overcome every trial because their trust was not based on human resources but on the grace of the Lord, who, as the readings of today's solemnity recall, delivers his friends from every evil and saves them for his kingdom (cf. Acts 12:11; 1 Tm 4:18).

It is this same trust in God which must also sustain us. Yes, the "Lord delivers his friends". This awareness must instill courage in us as we face the difficulties encountered in proclaiming the Gospel in daily life. May our holy patrons, Peter and Paul, sustain us and obtain for us that missionary zeal which made them witnesses of Christ to the ends of the then-known world.

Pray for us, holy Apostles Peter and Paul, "pillars" of God's Church!

Querida Familia de San Pancracio,

Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo. Son dos grandes pilares de nuestra Iglesia. Mucho se puede decir de ellos. Hoy, he pensado compartir un extracto de uno de los sucesores de San Pedro, el Papa San Juan Pablo II. De su homilía en esta Solemnidad de 1999:

«El Señor me libró de todas mis angustias» (Estribillo del Salmo responsorial). En su misión apostólica, san Pedro y san Pablo tuvieron que afrontar dificultades de todo tipo. Sin embargo, lejos de debilitar su acción misionera, fortalecieron su celo en beneficio de la Iglesia y para la salvación de los hombres. Pudieron superar todas las pruebas porque su confianza no se basaba en los recursos humanos, sino en la gracia del Señor, quien, como recuerdan las lecturas de esta solemnidad, libra a sus amigos de todos los males y los salva para su Reino (cf. Hch 12, 11; 1 Tm 4, 18).

Esa misma confianza en Dios debe sostenernos también a nosotros. Sí, el «Señor libra de todas las angustias». Esta certeza debe infundirnos ánimo frente a las dificultades que encontramos al anunciar el Evangelio en la vida diaria. Que san Pedro y san Pablo, nuestros patronos, nos ayuden y nos obtengan el celo misionero que los hizo testigos de Cristo hasta los confines del mundo entonces conocido.

Orad por nosotros, san Pedro y san Pablo apóstoles, «columnas» de la Iglesia de Dios.

Jesus Christ revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque the "Nine First Fridays" devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This involves the practice of receiving Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays of the month in reparation to "the heart that has loved men so and is loved so little in return. (Christ own words to St. Margaret Mary).

The reparation consists of:

- 1. Receiving Holy Communion on each First Friday of the month.
- 2. Completing the Nine First Fridays in nine consecutive months.
- 3. Making the Nine First Fridays in honor of and in reparation to Our Lord's Most Scared Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges and indifferences committed against it.



Our Lady of Fatima requested the practice of making reparation for sins of blasphemy and ingratitude against her Immaculate Heart on the First Saturday of five consecutive months.

This reparation consists of:

- 1. Confession (20 days before or after)
- 2. Receive Holy Communion.
- 3. Recite five decades of the Rosary.
- 4. Keep the Blessed Mother company meditating for a quarter of an hour on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.
