DID YOU KNOW?

What does grooming look like?

In practice, grooming relies on secrecy. Groomers use secrets to bind their child victims to them, starting with small secrets and working up to harmful ones, like abusive behaviors. Predators often use bribery ("I'll let you stay up late and watch TV if you let me do this."), threats ("I'll hurt you if you tell."), and withdrawal of affection ("I won't like you if you tell anyone the truth.") to keep children from disclosing abuse. Families should establish a "no secrets" rule, and never ask children to keep secrets from their parents or trusted adults. ¿Que es el engaño físico?

En la práctica, el engaño físico (conocido en inglés como grooming) se basa en el secreto. Los abusadores utilizan secretos para crear un vínculo con sus víctimas menores, comenzando con pequeños secretos y pasando a otros más dañinos, como comportamientos abusivos.

Estos depredadores suelen recurrir a comportamientos engañosos para manipular "te dejaré quedarte hasta tarde y ver la televisión si me dejas hacer esto", amenazar "te haré daño si lo cuentas a alguien", y retirar el afecto "no me gustarás si le cuentas la verdad a alguien" para evitar que los niños divulguen el abuso. Las familias deben establecer una regla de "no secretos" y nunca pedir a los niños que oculten secretos a sus padres o a adultos de confianza. 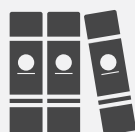

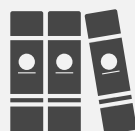
