I. **Topic:** PPE, Supplies & Materials, Tools and Equipments needed for Facial Treatment.

II. **Objectives:** At the end of this module, the Learners should be able to:

1. determine about PPE, Supplies & Materials, Tools and Equipment needed for Facial Treatment.
2. categorize the tools, supplies & materials and equipment for facial treatment services; and
3. appreciate the needed Supplies & Materials, Tools and Equipments for Facial Treatment in our daily lives.

III. Brief Introduction of the Lesson

As a Beautician, it is important to know the different tools, supplies, materials and equipment to be used in giving Facial Treatment. It is essential to familiarize those things prior the treatment in order for you to become competent and provide good service to your customers. Before you use any of these tools, make sure that they are thoroughly disinfected and/or sterilized. Ensure that all tools and materials are well prepared and neatly organized on the trolley. In Salon, Beautician and other staff are necessary to wear PPEs/Personal Protective Equipment in order to protect themselves from getting dirty and from chemical hazards. Also, to protect them from risk of injury or illnesses. Always Wash and sanitized hand using antibacterial soap and alcohol, before and after the service to ensure proper hygiene.

PPE, Supplies & Materials, Tools and Equipment Used In Facial Treatment;

PPE	Preparation	Uses	Maintenance
Face mask	Should be cleaned before used & place in a close container.	It is used to cover the nose & mouth for protection against chemical exposure.	Throw used face mask, the remaining should keep in a close container.
Apron	Make sure that the apron is clean before use.	Used to protect the cloth from dirt.	Wash and disinfect the aprons after use. Place it in a sealed cabinet.
Gloves	It should be cleaned before used place in a close container.	It is used for the whole hand to protect from germs.	Throw used gloves away in a close bin. Keep the unused gloves in a close container.
Smock Gown	Make sure that the smock gown for client is clean before use.	A loose, lightweight over garment worn to protect the clothing while working.	Wash and Disinfect the smock gown after use. If it's not in use place it in a sealed cabinet.
Facial headband	Should be cleaned and sanitized before use to prevent transferring of head lice.	It is used to hold the hair away from the <i>face</i> or eyes.	Wash and Sanitize Facial headband after use.
Tools	Preparation	Uses	Maintenance
Comedone Extractor	Sterilize your extractor by allowing it to sit in boiling water until it cools, or by using alcohol spray.	Help remove blackheads and whiteheads when used properly.	Wash and Disinfect after use, keep in a close container.
Facial bowl	Should be cleaned and sanitized before used.	Used for mixing ingredients together for facial scrub.	Wash and disinfect after used, then keep in proper place.
Facial Brush	Should be cleaned and sanitized before used.	It is used for exfoliating, polishing and improving your complexion.	Wash and disinfect after used, then keep in a close container.
Mirror	Should be cleaned and sanitized before used.	Used by client before, during and after the service so that they can see their face.	Wash and disinfect after used, then keep in proper place.
Facial Basin	Should be cleaned and sanitized before used.	Used for holding liquid.	Wash and disinfect after used, then keep in proper place.



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Supplies & Materials	Preparation	Uses	Maintenance
Facial tissues	Should be cleaned and place in a close container.	Soft, disposable paper tissue for cleansing the face.	Throw used facial tissue in close bin. The remaining facial tissues should keep in a close container.
Cotton wool	Dry cotton wool should be stored in a covered container. Damp cotton wool is placed in a cleaned bowl.	It is used for applying liquids or creams to your skin.	Throw used cotton after used. Keep the remaining cotton wool in a closed container.
Bath Towels And small hand towels	Towel should be white, clean and sanitized before using. Use one towel per Client.	Bath towels is use to cover the client's body during facial service. While the hand towels use to drape across the client's chest and shoulders.	Towel should be <i>*sanitized</i> through washing after use, then steam to further kill the bacteria. Keep them in proper place or close cabinet
Eye pads	Should be cleaned and place in a close container.	Help to reduce darkness and puffiness beneath the eyes, the most <i>* sensitive</i> skin on our body.	Throw used eye pads and the remaining should keep in a close container to avoid contaminated.
Spatula	It should be cleaned and use one spatulas per client.	Used for mixing and spreading facial ingredients.	Need to wash and disinfect after used, then keep in a close container.
Bed sheet	It should be cleaned and well sanitize before use. Placed it on the facial bed properly. Use one per client.	This is used as protector for facial bed and pillow.	The bed sheet should need to wash and sanitized after used. Keep them in close cabinet.
Equipment	Preparation	Uses	Maintenance
Magnifying Lamp	Should be clean and sanitize. Make sure it is stable before use.	Provide skincare specialists with an up-close view of a client's or patient's skin.	Must be disinfected and in place after used.
Waste bin	Should be Cleaned & close container for waste may be placed on the bottom shelf of the trolley.	Used to keep waste to reduce trash and keeping your area clean.	Must be wash and disinfect after used. Keep in proper designated area.
Trolley	Should be cleaned and sanitized before used. Make sure it is stable before use.	It is used for transporting tools and materials.	Need to wash and disinfect after used, then keep in proper place.
Facial bed	The bed should be cleaned and sanitized. Make sure it is stable before use.	Use as a base of support during Facial service.	Must be disinfected and in place after used.
Facial chair	The chair should be cleaned and sanitized. Make sure it is stable before use.	Use as a base of support during Facial service.	The chair must be disinfected and in place after used.
Beauty Stool	It should be cleaned and sanitized. Make sure it is stable before use.	It consists of a single seat, for one person, without back or armrests used in salon.	Must be disinfect and in place after used.
Facial steamer	It should be cleaned and sanitized. Make sure it is functional before use.	Used to open the pores in order to allow product to penetrate deeper, reveal smaller pores and skin color is improved.	Need to wash and disinfect after used, then keep in proper place.
