#### I. Topic: CLEANING COMPONENTS AND PERIPHERALS

#### II. Objectives:

- 1. identify the cleaning tools and peripherals;
- 2. follow safety measures in cleaning components and;
- 3. clean a computer device with safety.

#### III. Brief Introduction

Cleaning the components and peripherals helps keeps the computer in good working condition over the time. Depending on the environment that your computer operates will determine how often cleaning should be done.

#### **CLEANING TOOLS**

- 1. Lint Free Cloth– A cloth is the best tool used when rubbing down a component.
- 2. Water or Rubbing Alcohol solvent for moistening a cloth.
- 3. Portable Vacuum Sucking the dust, dirt, hair, and other particles out.
- 4. Cotton Swabs Wiping hard to reach areas and other locations.
- 5. Cable tie Bundle cables neatly inside and outside of a computer.
- 6. Soft Brush Soft bristle brushed to remove unwanted particles.

#### GENERAL CLEANING GUIDELINES

- 1. Turn off the computer when cleaning will be done.
- 2. Never spray or squirt any liquid onto any computer component.
- 3. Use a vacuum to suck up dirt, dust, or hair around the computer on the outside case.
- 4. Be cautious when using any cleaning solvents. Try to always use water or a highly diluted solvent.
- 5. Be careful not to accidentally adjust any knobs or controls.
- 6. Never eat or drink around the computer



- 12. Can protect electronic damages.






