I. Topic: **Assembling Long Pants**

II. Objectives:

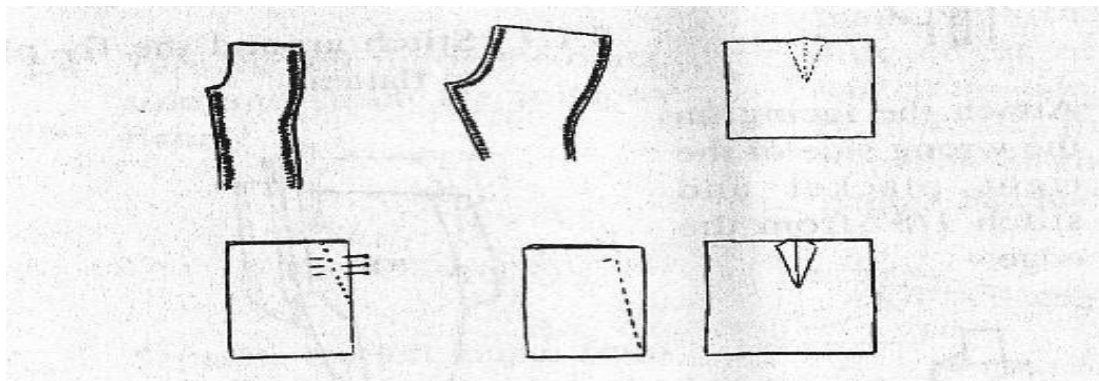
1. identify the parts of pants of Long pants.
2. determine the steps in assembling long pants.
3. value the importance of determining the techniques in assembling long pants.

III. Brief Introduction of the Lesson

Long pant is a garment extending from the waist to the knee or ankle, covering each leg separately. Compose of the waistband, belt loop, button, fly, pocket, crotch, hem, side seam, inseam, and zipper.

STEPS IN SEWING LONG PANTS

1. Over-edge the raw edges of the front and back legs.
2. Sew the back darts.
3. Fold the center of the dart lines, thread baste, or pin baste and dart, and open if the material is thick.
4. Assemble the back pocket.
5. Assemble the continental side pocket.
6. Prepare the left and right fly placket.
7. Attaching the left and right fly placket.
8. Join the side seams.
9. Prepare the waistband.
10. Sew on the waistband facing (right leg).
11. Sew on the waistband facing (left leg).
12. Join the inseams of the pants.
13. Join the right and left legs of the pants.
14. Prepare and the belt carriers.
15. Attach the belt carriers.
16. Finishing the bottom hem.

4. **O P T C T I H S T** – to stitch on the top an even distance from a seam edge or fold.
5. **N S P I** – to cut with a quick stroke using scissors.
