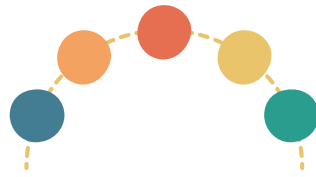

Ephesians 4:11 RESPONSIBILITY

1 APOSTLE

a messenger, one sent on a mission [Gk. 652 apóstolos (from 649 /apostéllō, "to commission, send forth") – properly, someone sent (commissioned), focusing back on the authority (commissioning) of the sender (note prefix, apo); apostle]

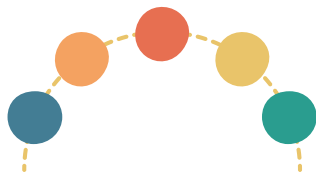


2 PROPHET

an interpreter, forth-teller of the divine will [Gk. (4396) prophētēs] declares the mind (message) of God, which sometimes predicts the future (foretelling) – and more commonly, speaks forth His message for a particular situation

3 EVANGELIST

bringer of good news [Gk. 2099 euaggelistēs (from 2097 /euaggelizō, "evangelize"); someone with a vocational calling from God to announce the good news of the Gospel]



4 PASTOR

shepherd [Gk. 4166 poimén – properly, a shepherd ("pastor" in Latin); (figuratively) someone who the Lord raises up to care for the total well-being of His flock (the people of the Lord)]

5 TEACHER

instructor [Gk. 1320 didáskalos (derived from 1321 /didáskō, "to teach") – a teacher, an instructor acknowledged for their mastery in their field of learning; in Scripture, a Bible teacher, competent in theology.]
