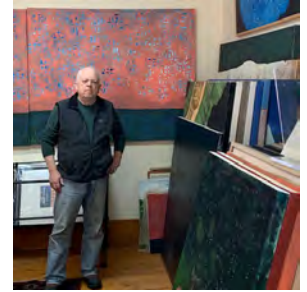


2a. HUGO ANDERSON

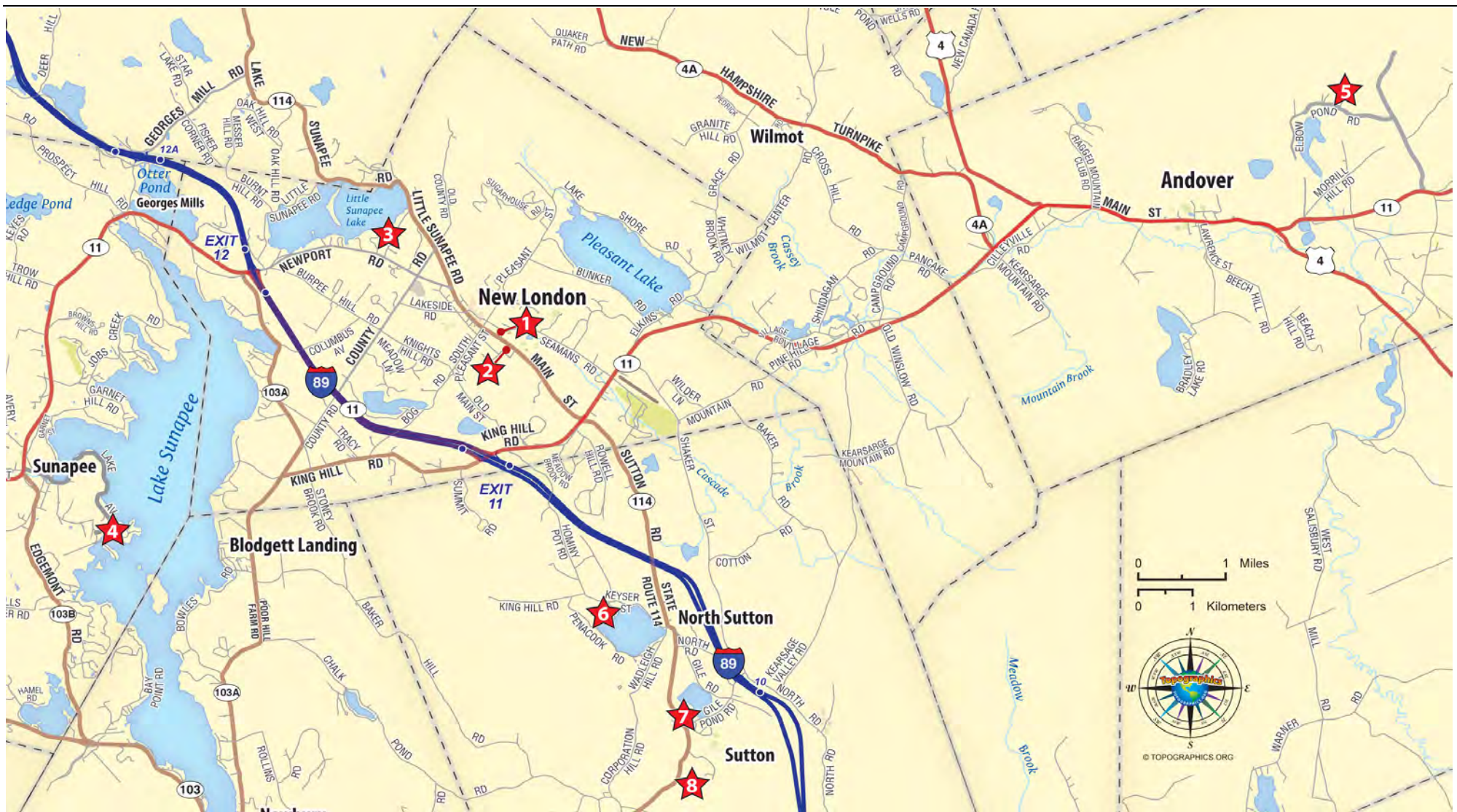

DIRECTIONS:

#1A-E WHIPPLE HALL: 429 MAIN ST. NEW LONDON.

FROM NORTH: I-89 exit 12; left on Newport Rd, 3.3 mi. to Seaman Rd.
 FROM SOUTH: I-89 exit 11; right on Rt. 11, 1 mi. to Rt.114, left 1.4 mi. to Seamans Rd.

#2A-B HUGO ANDERSON & PETER ANDERSON: 468 MAIN ST. NEW LONDON

FROM WHIPPLE: south on Main St. (Rt.114) 300 feet to #468.

#3 VICKI KORON: 182 CAMP SUNAPEE RD. NEW LONDON

FROM WHIPPLE: north on Main St. 0.75 mi; right at “Y” on Little Sunapee Rd; 1.0 mi. to Camp Sunapee Rd on left; 0.33 mi. to #182 Camp Sunapee Rd.

#4 LUCY MUELLER: 10 BIRCH POINT RD. SUNAPEE

FROM WHIPPLE: north on Main St. 0.75 mi; left at “Y” on Newport Rd; 7.5 mi. to Main St. Sunapee; left on Main 0.40 mi; changes to Lake Ave; 1.7 mi. to #10 Birch Point Rd.

#5A-B EDIBETH FARRINGTON & JAY FITZPATRICK: 443 ELBOW POND RD. ANDOVER

FROM WHIPPLE: south on Main St. 1.0 mi. to Rt. 11; left 9 mi. THRU Andover; stay left on Rt.11 at “Y”; 1.8 mi. to Old College Rd. on left; 1.0 mi. to Elbow Pond Rd. on left continue to #443. (Bridge is out so DON’T take Elbow Pond Rd. just after “Y”.)

#6 ROGER WELLS: 36 PARK AVE, NORTH SUTTON

FROM WHIPPLE: south on Main St. (Rt. 114) 3.75 mi. to Keyser St (at Church); right on Keyser 0.75 mi. (lake on left); to Park Ave on left; right at “Y”; 0.25 mi. to #36.

#7 LOREN HOWARD: 1270 RT. 114, NORTH SUTTON

FROM WHIPPLE: south on Main St. (Rt. 114) THRU N. Sutton Village, 5 mi. to #1270.

#8 LARRY HARPER: 1146 RT. 114, NORTH SUTTON

FROM WHIPPLE: south on Main St. (Rt. 114) THRU N. Sutton Village, 5.5 mi. to #1146. (very long driveway)
