PSALM 23 WEEK 2

Commentary on Psalm 23:2 by Claudio Carvalhaes in Upper Room Disciplines, April, 2024

As we repeat our reading of Psalm 23, another set of words comes to my heart: "God makes me lie down in green pastures; God leads me beside still waters." Let us read this backwards. The verses from last week said we "shall not want" because the Lord is our shepherd. This shepherd, the Lord, takes us to green pastures and beside still waters. That is why we shall not want, because we have what we need to eat and enough to drink.

Not long ago in Brazil, a poor mother of five children was put in jail because she stole five dollars worth of food for her and her children to eat. They were hungry. All she had was an empty belly and children to feed. The conditions of society prevented her from being able to be a good shepherd to her children and she was quickly punished for it. The judge who presided over her case—who earns an annual salary that in the US would be equivalent to \$100,000—decided to put this woman in jail, saying that she had a "harmful character."

This woman and this judge live in a world where a few have more than they need and many must always be in need. There exists enough for all in our world. How can we who have more than what we need shift to desire what God desires and be moved to share our wealth so that everyone can have enough?

Many churches inspire their members to demand that every single person should be provided with enough food and water, shelter, and care. What more can we as followers of Christ do to ensure that every person has what they need? Through our church work, we can create places that provide for all to have enough. Every time we eat and drink, let us remind ourselves of our Shepherd and the command we have to be our Shepherd's hands and feet in the world for others.

God, make me lie down in green pastures; lead me beside still waters. (Repeat three times.) Amen
