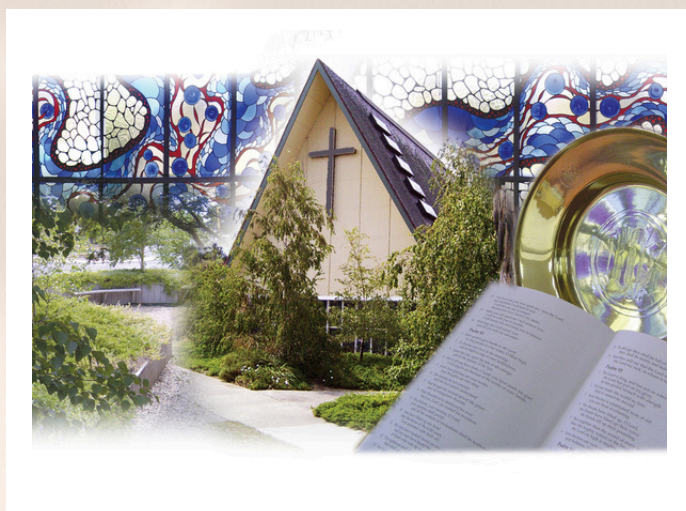

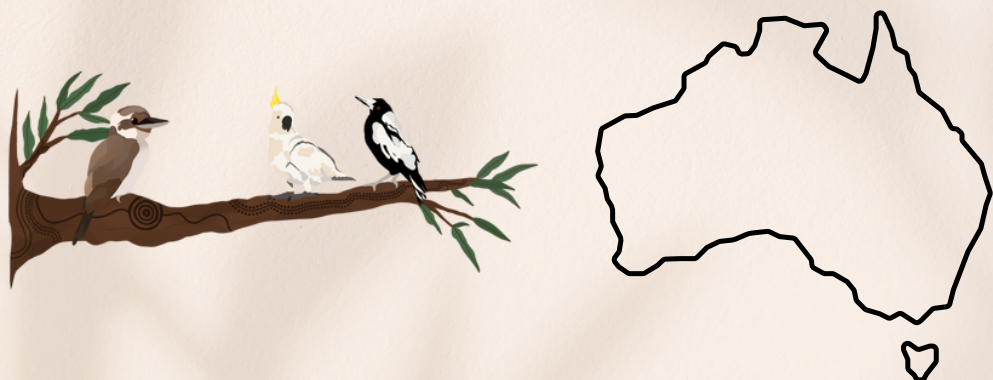
CHILD SAFE MINISTRY
