


A short time later, Sapphira came in, not knowing that her husband had died. She also lied about the money - and the same thing happened to her. Great fear came on all who heard these things.










But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out, and said, "Go, stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this


life." The apostles went out and began to preach about Jesus. In the morning, the High Priest's men found the jail empty.



In spite of their pain, the apostles obeyed God and carried on preaching about Jesus.


