But as you approach, you'll also find an inverted ziggurat on each of the four sides of the central structure. Each of these "reverse pyramids" extend 12 the ground and are lined with gran-ralls and grassy levels.

From above the memorial appears like a. Its surface features the same names Greek cross, with each of the five pyradisplayed on the monument's peak mids sitting at 40 feet by 40 feet.

POLICE MEMORIAL

At the top of the central monument lies a small, square reflecting pool. Engraved on the granite surface surrounding it are the names of 40 Houston police officers who sacrificed their lives in service to Mountain Frails & Buffalo Bayou Park Moroles envisioned the memorial site as a place that people would visit and explore with family and loved ones. An officer from Alabama successfully deployed spike strips, which caused the suspect vehicle to come to a stop. Deputy Minix exited his car and was giving commands to the arriving at the scene inadvertently struck him. He was transported to cumbed to his injuries. 
