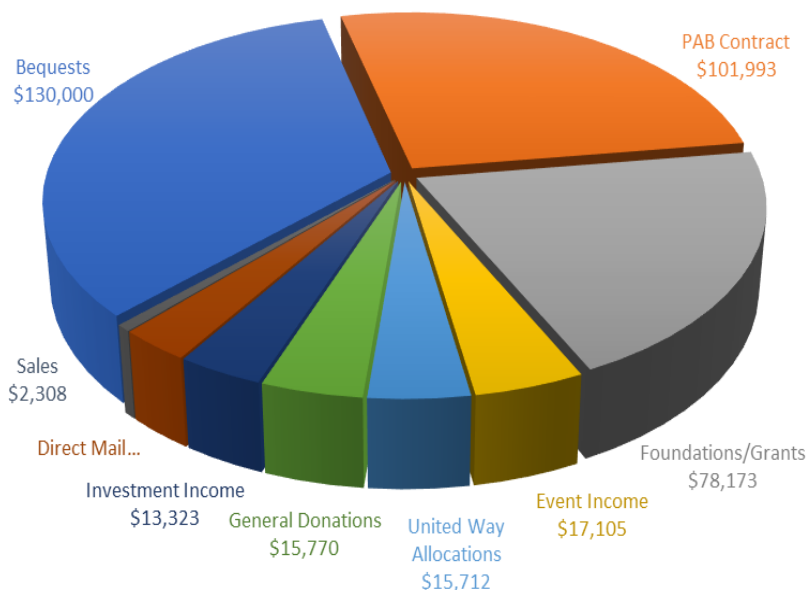

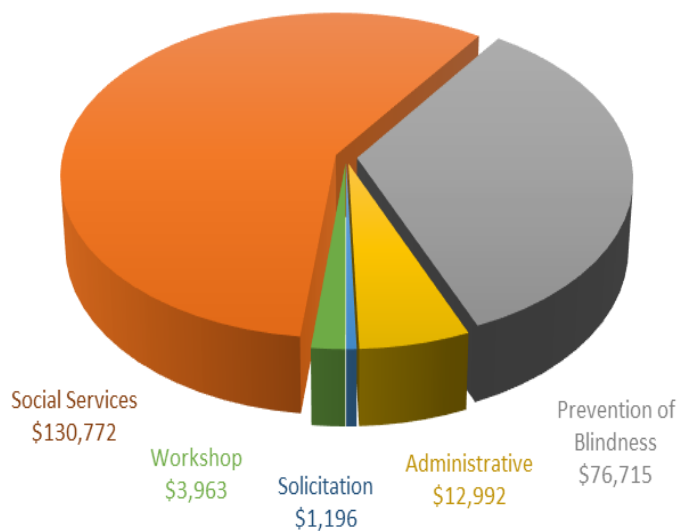

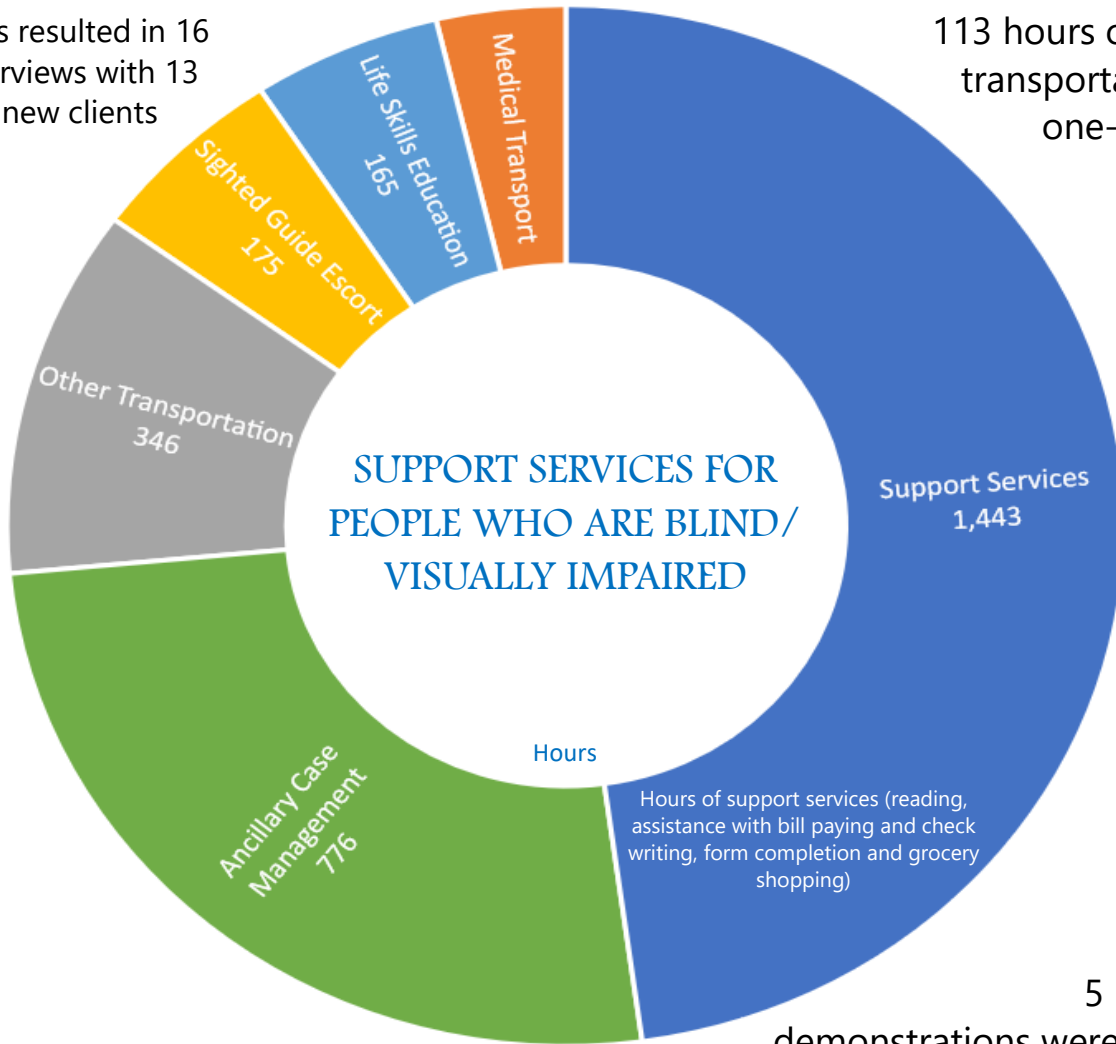
Income 2018

25 referrals resulted in 16 intake interviews with 13 becoming new clients

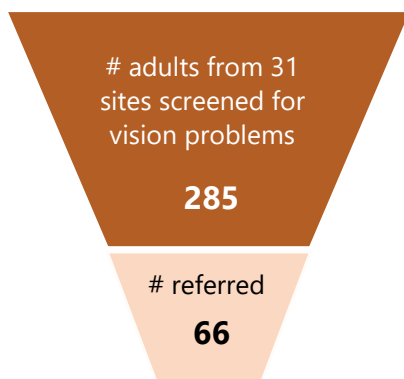

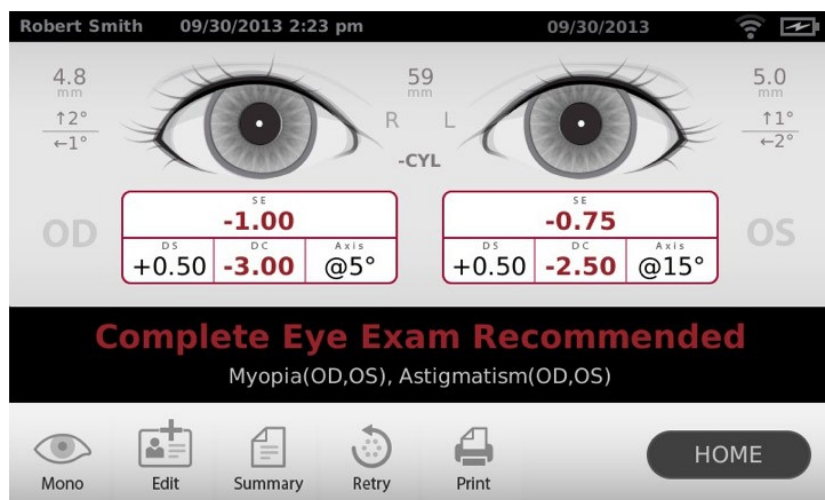
