To the members of CSSS' Community:

Central Susquehanna Sight Services' Board of Directors continue to monitor the everchanging developments relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, especially the guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Governor Wolf. (Currently, face masks are required for staff and clients.)

Normal business hours have resumed – Monday through Thursday, 8 AM – 4 PM and Friday 8 AM – 2 PM. All office visits will require an appointment. You will be required to wear a mask and answer a brief health questionnaire before entering the building. Valuable support services for our clients who are blind or visually impaired are a high priority for CSSS' staff. For those clients who are not comfortable going out for groceries, staff is able to go for them. All vision screenings, educational programs and the low-cost eye care program have been suspended until further notice.

This schedule will be maintained through June 5, 2020 at which time this schedule will be re-evaluated. Should the Northcentral Region of PA be moved to Phase Green, hours and services may be adjusted accordingly.

We will continue to take all the necessary steps and precautions to prevent, contain and minimize any potential exposure to the virus that CSSS could face to protect the vulnerable population that we serve. We are ensuring that best sanitizing practices are implemented. We are confident that with good hygiene practices, like washing your hand, sanitizing common areas, social distancing and self-monitoring, will help to minimize the impact of this virus and any other flu or colds.

CSSS will continue to monitor the situation closely and keep you informed of any changes.
