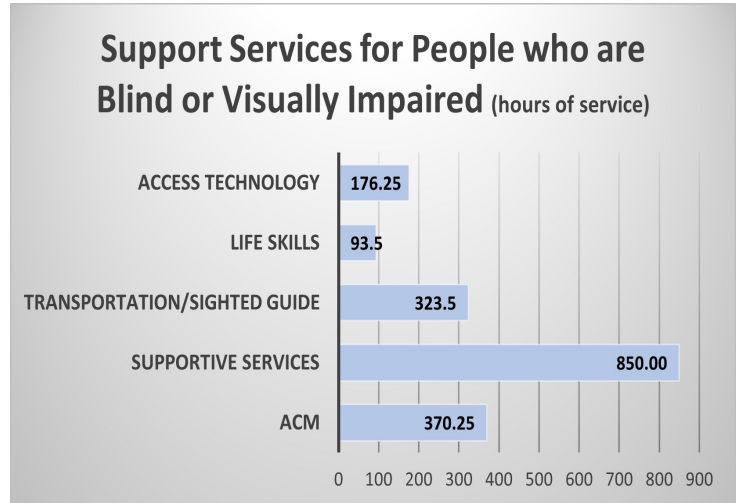

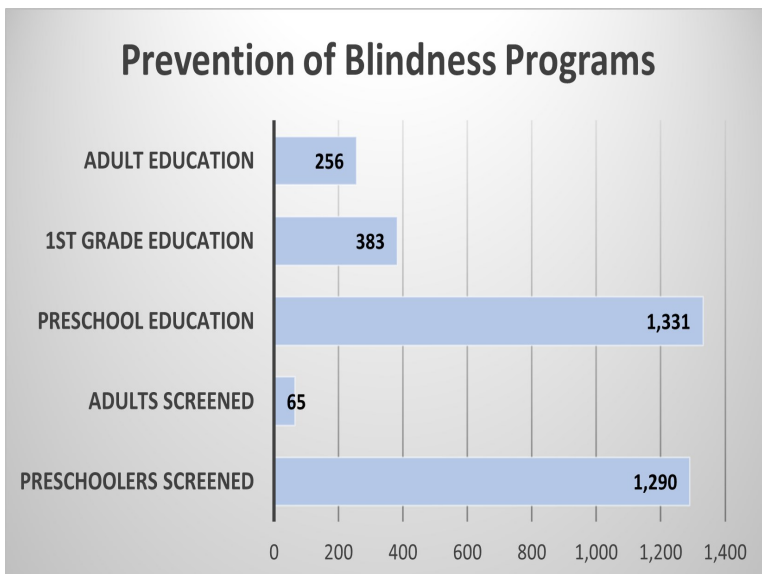
## SUPPORT SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE BLIND/VISUALLY IMPAIRED

34 referrals resulted in 7 intake interviews with 3 becoming new clients • 4 low vision demonstrations were provided • 10,816 miles were logged



## PREVENTION OF BLINDNESS
