

Entry Information & Horse Show Rules

Entry Deadline

All entries must be received or postmarked with payment by January 16, 2024 to avoid late fees.

Late Entries

Entries via mail must be submitted by January 16, 2024.

Late entries, on or after January 16 2024 up to February 09, 2024 will be accepted via email or online entries only, and only to be paid with credit card authorization/payment. No mailed entries will be accepted after January 16. Late fee of \$50 per horse is applicable.

The penalty for a late entry **at the show** is \$75 per horse. **All late fee/entries must be received no later than 1 HOUR before the first class of the day begins.**

ANY ENTRIES POSTMARKED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 16, 2024, or EMAILED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 16, 2024, OR RECEIVED AT SHOW WILL BE ASSESSED APPLICABLE LATE FEES.

Payment Policy

Entries may be paid by check or money order made payable to DNQHS, cash or credit/debit card. Payment due at time of entry. All forms of payment are to be in U.S. funds. An additional 4% convenience fee will be assessed to all credit/debit card charges.

Entries are not officially made until payment clears the bank.

A \$50 CHECK PROCESSING FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR ANY RETURNED CHECK.

Show Office is located in the southwest corner of Equine Center

Office will be open during show hours.

Monday 10 am until end of show.

Tuesday - Sunday - 7 am until end of show.

Animal Welfare

AQHA rules pertaining to animal welfare will be strictly enforced. Anyone found in violation of these rules may be subject to disqualification and/or penalties and fines as defined by AQHA rules.

Medication Rules

AQHA rules will be enforced. All horses are subject to drug testing by an AQHA representative.

Health Certificate Requirements: PLEASE NOTE

The MS Board of Animal Health requires that all horses entering the Mississippi Fairgrounds, including those from Mississippi, must have and present a current (12 months) negative EIA (Coggins) report and a 30 day Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate). Certificates will be checked by the MS. Board of Animal Health at the livestock gate (Gate 14).

No animals other than equine and cattle will be allowed inside buildings on the fairgrounds, except properly identified service animals.

Refunds/Substitutes

Refunds of entry and stall fees will only be considered in the event of death or serious injury of the horse entered. A signed and dated vet certificate must be presented at the show office no later than 5:00 pm on the afternoon prior to the first class entered. Any occupied stall is NON REFUNDABLE. Refunds will be sent to the agent who paid the entry fee(s). ***NO refunds for scratched entries.***

Any extenuating circumstances will be ruled upon by the Show Manager. Refund Form must be completed.

Substitutes will be considered due to lameness, injury or death only if the show manager is furnished with a veterinarian's written statement PRIOR to the time the class is called, and the substitute must be approved by the **show manager.**

Notify the show office/gate management of any change in exhibitors or the entry may be subject to disqualification.

Working Orders/Class Splits

Working orders and class splits will be posted by 8:30 PM the evening PRIOR to the class being held. Any late entries will be added to the working order at show management's discretion. Exhibitors **MUST** ride in splits or working order as posted UNLESS prior approval is given by the arena manager.

Stick Horse Class Rules:

For youth ages 10 and under. Western attire is preferred, spurs and chaps are optional. If you do not have western attire, come as you are and have fun. Participants will be "judged" at a walk, trot and lope going in both directions. Everyone is a winner. Every exhibitor will be able to keep their stick horse.

Patterns

Patterns will be posted on www.dnqhs.org web site by Feb. 01, 2024.

Patterns will be posted at the arena by 8:30 PM the evening prior to the day the class is held.

Practice Riding Schedule

Schedules for the Equine Center will be posted at the arenas and at the office. **The use of lunge lines will not be allowed in the Show Arena. These arena and areas will be supervised by appointed AQHA and MQHA personnel who will have the sole discretion to eject any exhibitor from said areas for inhumane treatment and/or training of their horse. Your cooperation will be expected!**

Exhibitor Numbers

Exhibitor numbers will be assigned to each horse at the time of entry, which shall stand for the entire show, and must be displayed whenever the horse is being exhibited. It is highly recommended for all performance classes, display the correct number on each side of saddle. In all halter and showmanship classes, the correct number must be displayed whenever the horse is being exhibited.

Motorized Vehicles – Restrictions

In accordance with Mississippi Fair Commission, no small motorized vehicles except golf carts or side by sides are allowed on the fairgrounds. ALL vehicles, INCLUDING GOLF CARTS, must be operated by a licensed driver.

Trailers

All trailers, loaded or empty, must only enter and exit **through Gate 14.**

RV Reservations

Dixie National does not take reservations for RV hook-ups. They are available on a first come, first serve basis.

Parking

Exhibitors may only park in designated areas. **Vehicles in FIRE LANES or NO PARKING AREAS will be towed. All fines and towing fees are at the owner's/operator's expense.**

Interpretation of Rules

The right to settle all questions or disputed incidents at the Dixie National Quarter Horse Show is reserved by the *Dixie National Quarter Horse Show Manager* or designated representative. All exhibitors or other participants, as a condition of admission, consent to such method and agree to be bound thereby by their entry form. Any objection to the award of the judge shall be lodged with the Show Manager immediately after the award is made.

Right of Removal

The Dixie National Horse Show Committee and Mississippi Quarter Horse Association reserves the right to prohibit any person or horse from showing and to remove any person or horse from the grounds, for ANY REASON, without being liable for compensation.

Right of Cancellation

The Mississippi Quarter Horse Association can cancel any events without notice and without liability any time prior to the contests. In this case, unused fees will be refunded as applicable.

Photography and Videographer Release

The Mississippi Quarter Horse Association may film and photograph spectators, owners, trainers, exhibitors and horses participating in the Dixie National Quarter Horse Show to compile publicity, live Webcast of the event or for use in promotional materials, as it determines. By participating, owners, trainers and exhibitors agree that no compensation shall be due from MQHA, the Dixie National or any third party for the publications and/or broadcast of their likeness, picture and names, etc. All participants agree, understand and acknowledge that Official Dixie videographers, photographers and media approved by MQHA have full access to the Dixie at any time. This includes the use of flashes and other photo and video equipment. All exhibitors agree and understand that they should be prepared for official photographers, videographers and/or approved media taping and /or taking pictures of warm-ups, competition, etc., and upon this condition only are entries accepted.

Liability for Loss or Damage

The Dixie National Committee, Mississippi Quarter Horse Association & the Mississippi State Fairgrounds assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to persons, horses or personal property, from any cause, and upon this condition only are entries accepted.

Media Credentials

To obtain media credentials, please fill out the media credential form available at www.dnqhs.org and send the completed form to mississippiqhs@gmail.com. All media credential requests must be received by January 14, 2024, so that all necessary information can be sent to you prior to the show. If requests are not received by January 14, 2024, credential requests must be made at the show office and approved by the show manager. Upon arrival, all media representatives must stop by the show office to pick up their media packet. Additional background information, news releases and assistance setting up interviews with show officials will be available there as well. Please refrain from approaching exhibitors who are about to enter the arena to compete. Also, please note that the members of the media are not permitted to enter the arena during competition.

Class Fees and Pay Backs

Entry fees for each class are designated by the class listing.

Payback (PB) is the portion of the entry fee which will be added back into any award monies.

Entry fees do not include AQHA admin fees or office charges.

Additional fees per horse:

AQHA Admin Fee	\$40.00	
Office charge	\$20.00	
Grounds fee per day*	\$25.00	*only horses without a stall

FLAT FEE \$350: this covers AQHA class fees, office charge, AQHA admin fees and is per horse. It does not include NSBA, VRH, Mississippi Championship, cattle, speed classes, stall, grounds fee, shavings or RV.

FLAT FEE \$350 VRH: This covers VRH class fees, office charge, AQHA admin fees and is per horse. It does NOT include stall, grounds fee, cattle fees, shavings or RV.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded under each judge for first through tenth place. All class awards will be determined based on composite placings of all four judges and the composite winner will be "Dixie National Champion".

EXCEPTIONS: In timed events and roping, money awards will be based on time. In case of ties, money will be divided equally among exhibitors involved with one judge pre-designated as tie-breaker for non-monetary awards.

Awards Pickup

All awards must be picked up at the Awards booth prior to the close of the show. The show will not be responsible for shipping or otherwise delivering any prizes to exhibitors who have departed prior to the prizes being awarded. Exception will only apply to monies to be received via check.

Exhibitor Responsibility

Each Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and understanding all applicable AQHA, NSBA and Dixie rules and procedures. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the prizes for which they are eligible. By competing for a prize, the exhibitor is effectively attesting to his or her eligibility for that prize. Any awards or payouts received at The Dixie for which the horse or exhibitor is found to be ineligible must be returned to The Dixie immediately at the exhibitors cost. EXHIBITOR will be suspended from any MQHA Shows until returned,

Dixie National Jackets will only be awarded to AQHA Class winners, Small Fry Class winners, All Breed class winners VRH and Mississippi Championship class winners unless otherwise noted. **Jackets will not be awarded to NSBA winners. Class winners are responsible for the cost of custom embroidery to garment.**

Award payouts for AQHA Classes

Open and Amateur AQHA classes may be awarded a monetary prize. Payout is noted by each class eligible for a monetary prize.

Monetary payout percentages, unless otherwise noted by class information

Payout percentage does not change based on number of entries.

1st Place	32%
2nd Place	22%
3rd Place	19%
4th Place	10%
5th Place	9%
6th Place	8%

All monies paid are based on Composite Placing. If a class has been notated (PB) beside the entry fee, the specified amount times the number of horses shown will be added to the winnings, along with any added money also listed by the class.

Premium Payments

All monies will be paid to the individual who pays the entry fee, unless otherwise specified in writing to the show secretary at the time of entry. **A W-9 must be filled out with the finance office prior to awarding any prize money.** Prize money will be paid per listed schedule for AQHA classes, NSBA rules for NSBA classes. All timed events and roping monies will be calculated based on the number of horses SHOWN in the class, except where rules state otherwise. Unclaimed checks will be mailed by March 31, 2024 and must be cashed within ninety days. No claims will be honored by the Dixie National after July 1st of the year in which the premiums are won.

It is the goal of Dixie National staff to have payback checks available in the Finance office one hour following the conclusion of the class. If not picked up, checks will be mailed by March 31, 2024 as long as all entry fees have been paid, bank cleared and all required information has been received.

Level 1 Youth and Level 1 Amateur High Point and Reserve High Point Awards

Level 1 Youth and Level 1 Amateur High Points will be based on the number of points earned in Level 1 classes along with youth or amateur halter being counted. Level 1 Walk Trot classes do not count for this level.

Level 1 Youth & Level 1 Amateur Walk Trot High Point & Reserve High Point Awards

Level 1 Youth or Level 1 Amateur Walk Trot High Points will be based on the number of points earned in Level 1 Walk Trot Classes. Exhibitor must show in a minimum of 3 level 1 walk trot performance classes. Level 1 showmanship will count as one performance class. Youth or Amateur Halter points will count towards this award.

Small Fry Walk Trot High Point & Reserve High Point

Small Fry Walk Trot is for exhibitors that are 10 years of age and younger. The High Point award will be based on number of points earned in Small Fry classes, Youth Halter points will be included. No Small Fry Exhibitor may show in any canter or lope class at this show, but may cross enter in the Level 1 Youth Walk/Trot classes. AQHA rules apply and ownership must meet AQHA Level 1 requirements

Amateur & Select Amateur All Arounds and Reserve Awards & Andre'Hopkins All Around Youth & Reserve Awards

All Arounds will be in accordance to AQHA rule SHW 803.5: "To be eligible for all around honors, an Amateur in the Amateur division, Select Amateur in the Select Amateur division, or Youth in the Youth division must compete in three or more AQHA categories in one division (Amateur, Select Amateur, or Youth classes)

*****Only points earned in the specific divisions will count toward each all-around award (halter points will count for the Select Amateur and Amateur all arounds). *****

If the select and amateur classes are combined into amateur, the points will count in the class the exhibitor originally entered.

Versatility Ranch Horse All Arounds and Reserve Awards

All Arounds for VRH will be awarded to Youth, Open, Amateur, Limited Amateur, & Limited Youth divisions based on AQHA VRH Rules.

High Point/All Around ties

In the case of a tie for any all-around or high point award AQHA rule SHW 803.9 will be followed.

She won numerous World & Reserve World championships at the AQHYA World Championship Show. In high school rodeo competition, she represented Mississippi at the National Finals in 2000-2003.

Tie Down roping was CC's favorite event. She worked with Gary Wells for countless hours to hone both her skills and the skills of her beloved horses. CC was the epitome of the mentality that "anything is possible". She displayed this motto and inspired others throughout her life.






