If the occupant does not follow this prep sheet we will not guarantee results. The service tech will be the only person who determines whether the occupant is ready or not. Center of living room, kitchen table or bathtub make good storage areas. For 1 week after treatment you will see an increase in pest activity. This is the result of the treatment driving pests out of their nesting site. Do not perform self treatments at anytime. Keep dogs, cats and reptiles outside of premise or inside bedroom with towel covering gap under door. Keep fish tanks covered with a towel. Please allow 2-3 hours until entry after service is completed. If you are pregnant, have allergies or any other medical condition please notify us in advance. Be prepared to leave once the tech arrives.

- 1. Remove food (canned and boxed) and non food items out of kitchen and bathroom cabinets.
- 2. Move refrigerator and stove one foot away from wall for treatment.
- 3. Eliminate all fats, oils and grease build up areas. Pay special attention to walls and behind stove.
- 4. Clean up crumbs, spills and trash and keep kitchen and restroom clutter free.
- 5. Fill all plumbing voids in kitchen and bathroom and holes to floor heaters.
- 6. Pull all items in living room, dining room and bedrooms away from the wall 1 foot for treatment
