I hope y'all are not tired of hearing about Project Grace. This idea is one of the most amazing things I have been a part of. I love the enthusiasm being exhibited by those already helping with the program!!

The act of helping children by giving something that will belong to them alone during a time of devastation, separation and illness will not go unnoticed. So far, Quilts of Grace and Yarns of Grace have reached out to over 200 children in the Uvalde area and it increases weekly.

We are thrilled to say that after much planning and creating, Toys of Grace has begun! Wooden cars, created in our own wood shop, will be given by police, sheriff, fire department and hospital personnel to children who have experienced trauma or are ill. Even in a traffic stop where the child may be upset, receiving a gift from the officer could help the child overcome any fear they may experience.

Toys of Grace is another element of Project Grace, which is named after Grace Bridges who was born with Cystic Fibrosis. In addition to CF, Grace's stomach and intestines were not connected. Spending 65 days in the hospital at birth Grace was finally able to go home but will continue to fight CF unless a cure is found. She is doing very well today, but each day is different. Project Grace reminds us that there are hurting children in our community either due to illness, tragedy, abuse, neglect and so much more. By making and giving items of comfort such as toy cars, quilts and crochet items, not only helps those who receive but also those who contribute their time, talents and donations of supplies and money.

Jackie Thomas, who works with Toys of Grace along with several more volunteers, shares of how excited she is to help get this program started. Jackie, who's husband Homer passed away over a year ago, has said how Toys of Grace has put a spring back into her step. We can see that Jackie and are so glad that you are a

part of this project.

Thank you to all the volunteers who are already creating toys. We can't wait to see where this goes. If you would like to help with any part of Project Grace, please give us a call. You will not be sorry.
