Balance can be a noun: an even distribution of weight, enabling someone or something to remain upright and steady

Balance and seniors are of serious concern for people, no matter what your age. Falls are a major concern for seniors. Declining strength, coordination, mobility and visibility all increase our risk of falling. The good news is that it is possible to lower that risk. Exercise is one of those ways. Exercises that focus on building your strength and increasing your sense of balance will reduce your risk of falling as well as assisting in your recovery from injuries received in a fall.

Herby Ham Activity Center offers several ways to assist with this. Water aerobics, Line Dancing, Circuit Gym and yoga are all available.
