Covid-19 was difficult for everyone. For children who suffer abuse, it proved to be even worse, putting them, for a longer period of time, in the hands of their abusers.

Since September of 2018, Quilts of Grace have created and donated over 800 quilts to CASA. We will be celebrating this milestone by holding a reception Wednesday, May 26th at 1 pm. HHAC has been gifted a beautiful piano from Janet and Bob Copenhaver to use during events such as our Old




Fashioned Ice Cream Social, Gospel Night Out and much more.
