Along with holding blood drives where over 250 units were donated, we also hosted receptions for 14 families, housed numerous organizations and put on a luncheon for the Robb staff. You didn't have to look hard for the helpers because they were everywhere. I can't say THANK YOU enough! We at HHAC are honored to be a part of the process.

This is what I mean by "I am glad I was here" with so many others who brought positive efforts to our community. I personally feel both honored and unworthy to have been given that privilege.

I pray 2023 will be a year of healing for Uvalde especially those affected, even in places beyond our borders, that broken hearts

and damaged relationships are mended, and Uvalde sets the example in healing and love toward one another. Let's see ourselves when we look for the helpers.

BOARD SPOTLIGHT—DEE ANN SMITH

We all know life can be tough and there are times we may wonder “why”. So many in our community have asking that same question. Dee Ann and Jimmy Smith have been among them.

Meeting in college, while both working at a grocery store, they have now been married for 37 years, Dee Ann and Jimmy moved from Arlington to Knippa 17 years ago. Both worked for Health and Human Services where Dee Ann retired after 27 years.

Dee took the position as HHAC’s Board President in 2021 after serving as a board member for 2 years. Asking why she wished to serve as Board President she said “I really like the different activities offered to the adults in our community and wish to get them more involved with each other through activities and creating new friendships”. Dee Ann was very active in the pool, wood shop and brought new life to our lobby during holidays and dances through her decorating ability. Each year our Christmas tree took on a different theme. Dee Ann was also instrumental in bringing “Trim-A-Tree Project” to HHAC where organizations set up and decorate a tree and gather donations of non-perishable food for the Uvalde Food Bank. Vacationing is one of Dee and Jimmy’s favorite things to do. Taking several trips throughout the year they went to Spain during Thanksgiving of 2021. While crossing the street she had terrible fall. She knew right away something was wrong ,couldn’t move and instantly began to pray. “I heard God ask me,” “Why are you worried Child? I am with you”. “At that moment I stopped worrying”. Being paralyzed from the neck down, Dee spent 18 days in

Dee was finally sent to Houston where she spent 6 months in a hospital and later a long term care facility where she made the most progress.

“In January while in the hospital I lost 10 units of blood due to a GI bleed and was going in and out of consciousness, I asked God to take me.” He said “It is not your time my Child.”

Able to return to Knippa in May, they were greeted with a home adapted for her by her friends and church family from Emmanuel Lutheran. “It has been overwhelming for Jimmy, but we are making it with the help of my family and friends. They have been so supportive. So much food was brought over for a month and so many helped,” Dee said.

She is now able to move her left arm and hand, to where she can feed herself. This is a huge accomplishment. Being right handed, Dee said it has been a learning experience. Now having movement in her right hand also and able to hold objects is promising. There is also slight movement in her legs and feeling in her hip.

Asking how she is getting though this Dee Ann said, “I try to keep my thoughts positive and not let the trials bring me down. God knows I am not a very patient person. I need continued prayers for patience and healing. I feel like a modern day Job.” Sharing her favorite scripture, Philippians 4:13, “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me,” Dee continues to show that strength from God and endurance not letting the “why’s” keep her down.
