When we first began to apply for our Bingo license in November of 2018 we were hoping to start playing January of 2019. To our surprise, we were informed we had to take it to a county vote which put

us off another year. In November of 2019 we had the vote and it passed with a majority of 87%! Applying the second time was a little easier only because I knew a little more as to what I was doing but the mound of paperwork still had to be completed and signed by numerous people including county officials. Come January of 2020, we hit the ground running and did absolutely fantastic the first 2 and a half months. Then.....well you know, Covid hit and hit with a fury. Justifiably, after opening back up from being shut down, we went from averaging 150 plus in attendance to just over 30. Due to reduced numbers, our pay-out had to be reduced, which our players didn't like but we could not pay out more that what we took in. We never were able to fully recover.

On Friday, October 8, the decision was made to put our Bingo on temporary hold. It was a hard decision to make. We have a couple of options that myself and the board are considering but nothing has been decided yet.

Many have called or talked to me out in the community sharing how sorry they are that we stopped having Bingo. They also told me their opinion as to what happened. I appreciate the support so many continued to give us even when we had to reduce payouts. Thank you!

No one knew Covid would hit. We are blessed HHAC is still operating and planning for the future. For instance, on Saturday, November 20th our Brisket Plate Sale will be held at 333 E Main. Presale tickets are available at the Center or drop by the location the day of the event. 
