Looking back I realized how strong I was. I remember one day I fixed my fence, the ac on my car and my dryer. In time, I got my finances in order like never before and worked at a job where I led my team to often become number one in the nation in sales. Looking back can be good. It gives a since of accomplishment, but it is done some time later.

I pray that Uvalde experiences the same thing... that one day we can look back and see the good that has been done in the midst of tragedy, share the things we have learned and realize how really strong we have become.

I pray one day this community will be able to reach out as others have to us, offering help in the occurrence of disaster. For instance on May 25th I received a call from my new friend, Rabbi Ron with the Jewish Community Center in Pittsburg. Being a similar organization, he reached out to us offering what help he could including toys and books for our community. Their event happened in 2018. He shared with me what they have learned, what has changed and what they hope to see in the their future. Their community came together, but it took time.

I pray for healing for our community...for the families and friends who have lost a part of their heart, for even our environment and how we pictured our future prior to these events.


