## QUILTS OF GRACE,...

## JUST ONE OF HHAC'S MINISTRIES

Herby Ham Activity Center formed Quilts of Grace in 2018 to be an outreach to children in Uvalde County through **Bluebonnet Children's Advocacy Center**. Quilts of Grace gave comfort quilts to over 1800 children prior to May 24th and over 3000 after the tragedy to survivors, children, families, teachers, social agencies,



first responders and medical personnel.

One of the agencies who are on-going recipients of quilts from Quilts of Grace is **The Children's Bereavement Center of South Texas** whose mission is to foster healing for grieving children, youth, their families and the community. Every quilt that is provided is given to a family as a symbol of love and support they receive from the Uvalde community and beyond. A representative from CBC of South Texas said, "Together we can continue to help carry the heartache for so many. Thank you, Quilts of Grace,

for providing us these beautiful, handmade quilts. Our work is not

possible without your support!"

In speaking with an employee with **Alamo EMS**, they shared of how comforting the quilts have been for their employees The beds in their break room are covered with Quilts of Grace Quilts. "You can feel the love put into each one. It reminds us how so many in this community continue to reach out helping even months after the event".





**Hillcrest and Rushing Estes Knowles Funeral Homes** were also greatly involved after the tragedy. Working with the families who lost so much took a toll for so many who counseled and served in this much needed service. **Monika Saiz Martinez** of Hillcrest Funeral Home said "I was right across the street from the school when it happened; so many children flooded in to seek protection. Sleeping at night became more and more difficult. Quilts of Grace gave each of us on staff a quilt of our very own. Knowing each one was prayed over brought a sense of comfort and rest". Asking about any quilts she gave to others, Monika said, "A little boy who was in the school was having a lot of struggles. The look on his face was priceless when he received his quilt. He was so

grateful and I could tell it was something special to him." Monika has also given quilts to patients struggling with cancer. "They held on to them like a lifeline. They are so grateful".

Monika said in closing ,"I want you to know, there were 3 things given to me after the tragedy that are and remain precious... a Uvalde Strong necklace, a massage that was gifted to me helped to calm me and my Quilts of Grace Quilt which covers my had and will be with me wherever I may ge

of Grace Quilt which covers my bed and will be with me wherever I may go reminding me of the love it represents".

**Ed Gentry**, Executive Director of **Bluebonnet Children's Advocacy Center** has shared about the children they work with, "Often , when a child is removed from their home due to abuse or neglect, they come with nothing, even without clothing. These quilts are the first thing to wrap around them during this very hard time in their lives. When the children come for follow up counseling almost always they have their quilt with them".



HHAC's board member, Gabe Gonzales, shared ," Something not many think of is when a child is taken from their home by CPS. Where someone may think it is just a quilt it is so much more. It may be all he or she feels they have at the moment." Gabe and his family were personally affected by the tragedy also received a QoG quilt. "My son, who was at the school at the time, loves to snuggle under his quilt. Quilt of Grace is such an asset to Uvalde."



Quilts of Grace's focus was and continues to be children who have been removed from their homes through CPS or have faced a traumatic experience. That problem is not going away. As long as there is abuse and neglect towards our children there will be a need for outreach programs such as Quilts of Grace. 
