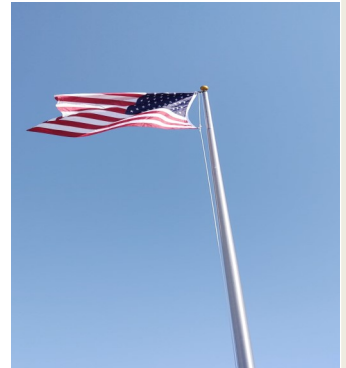
SUE'S CORNER
