The instant agreement is for the rental of one kayak, stand up paddleboard, canoe and/or equipment (collectively called "rental equipment") This agreement also constitutes a Waiver and Release of Liability, whereby the Renter agrees to release, discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify Lessor and its owners, agents, officers and employees from any and all claims, actions or losses for bodily injury, property damage, wrongful death, loss of services or otherwise which may arise out of Renter's use of Rental Equipment, or Renter's presence at Lessor's premises or facilities. By signing this document, Renter acknowledges he/she is releasing, discharging and waiving any claims or actions that he/she may have at the present time, or any future time, for the negligent acts, omissions or other conduct by Lessor's owners, agents, officers or employees.
