Who can apply?

Any certified teacher can apply for ...

Individual/Teacher
(Max. \$500)

Grade Level/Department
(Max. \$1500)

OR

Elementary PE and Music are considered two separate departments and can therefore, each apply for a separate department grant (up to \$1500 each).

Any instructional coach can apply for...

- ▶ A grant that serves a grade level/department or entire campus
- ▶ Maximum - \$1500

Any principal can apply for...

- ▶ An ALL CAMPUS GRANT that serves all students on the campus.
- ▶ Maximum - \$2500
- ▶ AP or other staff designated by the principal can apply on behalf of the principal. Must have principal approval and each campus can only submit ONE all campus grant application

Requirements

Do Not include...

- ❑ School name
- ❑ Teacher's name
- ❑ Principal's name
- ❑ Any other identifying information

...on attachments, within file names or anywhere within the application unless specifically requested.

Principal approval is **mandatory** for the grant application and any non-SAISD approved vendors.

Excel Spreadsheet

- An itemized excel spreadsheet of ALL expenses including shipping & handling is **required**.
- The total amount listed on the spreadsheet must match the exact amount requested on the application.
- Do not include any identifying information on the spreadsheet or within the file name.

Funding Sources

- ▶ If your total exceeds the maximum grant award, the additional funding source **MUST** be explained.
- ▶ Examples:
 - ▶ Campus funds approved by principal (do not list campus or principal's name)
 - ▶ PTO/PTA
 - ▶ Personal

DEFINE YOUR PROJECT

- Give your project an identifying title
- Explain clearly and concisely
- Define terms and avoid educational acronyms
- Use correct grammar
- Bring your idea to life
- Share how your idea will enrich the learning experience


Remember: Not all grant readers are educators.



Follow-up

All paperwork including receipts and evaluation, should be turned in upon completion of your project or before the end of the school year.



Failure to follow  ALL instructions will result in disqualification of the application.
