The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection offers the Interim Household Treatment Program to provide free water filtration units to public water system customers in small and disadvantaged communities, to address the emerging contaminants like PFAS and manganese.

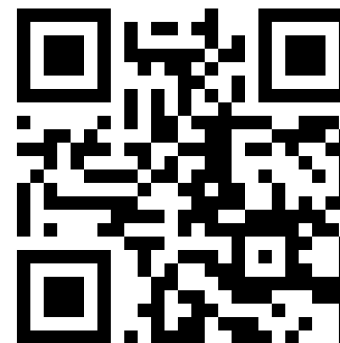
Paper versions of the application will be available at the Canyon GID office.

Receiving the Filter

On the application there are two methods for receiving your counter top filter. You may choose to have it delivered at the address provided on the application, or pick up the filter from the Canyon GID offices.

For delivery there is no set timeline for when you will have your filter delivered. Canyon GID will do their best to deliver the units within 3-weeks of applying.

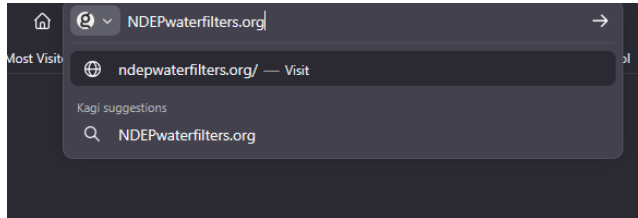
If you selected pick up, Canyon GID will be open for walk-in during normal business hours.



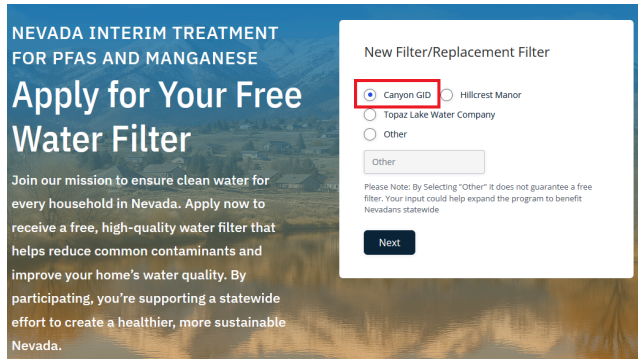

Step-by-Step Instruction for Online Application:

1. Scan the provided QR Code with your mobile device, or if you're on a computer, type the following URL into your browser: **NDEPwaterfilters.org**
