Architectural Review Board (ARB)

The ARB reminds all homeowners to submit an ARB Request and be approved BEFORE starting any projects. Any changes to the exterior of your home (decks, patios, driveway, landscaping, trees, paint, roofing, irrigation, fences (including temporary Horse Fences), etc., must have prior approval from the ARB before you start the project. Failure to secure prior approval could result in a violation or fine (up to \$100) and may require you to stop work or remove any improvements you have made. ARB Forms are available in the Clubhouse Lobby or on the website. Email requests are not accepted.
