## **ARB** (Architectural Review Board)

The <u>ARB would like to remind homeowners to get an ARB Request approved BEFORE</u> <u>starting any projects</u>. ANY changes to the exterior of your home (decks, patios, driveway, landscaping, fences, trees, painting, roofing, irrigation, etc) MUST have PRIOR APPROVAL from the ARB BEFORE YOU START THE PROJECT. Failure to secure prior approval could result in a violation or fine (up to \$100) and may require that you stop work or remove any improvements that you have made. Requests for approval forms are available on the website (<u>www.rainbowbendnv.com/forms</u>) or in the Clubhouse. Please deposit the form in the box labeled ARB in the lobby. **Email requests are not accepted**. Paint requests must have samples. For more information, please contact any member of the ARB.

## Clubhouse INT/EXT Committee -

- A timer for the Sport Court lights has been installed. Residents can now turn on the lights for an hour when needed during the evening and the lights will shut off at 10 pm.
- The Board approved new awnings which were installed at Lot A (adjacent to the Clubhouse).
- Remodel Project (pool & locker room areas): Our General Contractor is finalizing all details & drawings to send RFPs to subcontractors, following Board approval.
- We will be changing one of the pool area single glass doors to a double door which will require a 2-3 day midweek closure in early June. We will post actual dates once confirmed.

• Lawn Mowing Dots is either a green or red painted dot on the curb in front of your residence, to let the mowers know whether your property is to be serviced (mow, weed, or feed) or not. Reno Green, in coordination with the Landscaping Committee, will now be responsible for painting these dots. If you want your lawn serviced, you should have a green dot. Alternatively, if you don't want the service, you should have a red dot. If your property doesn't have a dot or you wish to change the dot selection, please contact the Landscaping Committee.

• **Community Parks along Couleurs:** The Board approved purchasing new picnic tables for the parks and the repair/painting of the gazebo.

**Horses** - The horses are managed and controlled by The Wild Horse Connection (WHC). The WHC is a private 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose mission is to keep the Wild Horses of the Virginia Range Free, educating the Community about living with our Mustangs and rescuing those that have to be removed from the range. **It is important to know that it is illegal to feed wild horses in Nevada**. <u>If you feed illegally in your yard, then the horses learn to come there for food</u>. **NV Energy Conversion**- The propane to natural gas conversion is moving right along, with completion expected in late October. NV Energy will be coordinating with each household beginning the first week of July and working through the neighborhood from west to east. They have contracted with Brycon Construction to convert/replace our appliances and switch over the fuel supply for each house. They will utilize temporary propane tanks as needed so no house will ever be without one of the fuels. In 2022, the RBHOA signed a Temporary License Agreement with NV Energy to use a portion of our parking area at the corner of Couleurs & Rouge for this project, for which we received \$11,000.
