And guide them through.

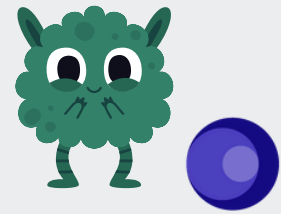
Give me the wild children,

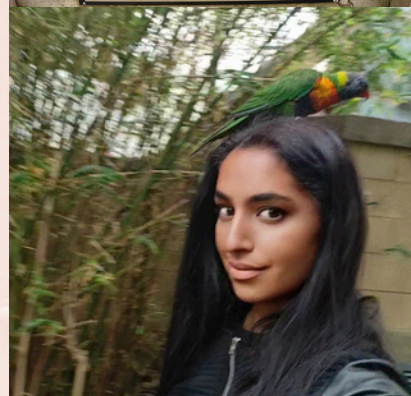
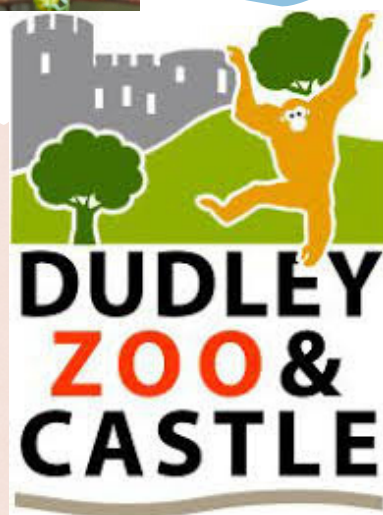
Forest School
