these diaper banks and their staff and volunteers served on the front lines of Loudoun County's COVID-19 pandemic response helping families in our community weather the crisis.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim September 18-24, 2023, as in Loudoun County.
