Thursday, May 1, 2025

3:00 PM: Camping Arrival

Participants and vendors with camping reservations may begin arriving. Staff will be available to assist with check-in and parking logistics.

Note: No mountain riding or access to the ski lodge until Friday.

Please note that mountain riding is not allowed on Thursday. The lodge will be closed, and there will be no food available. Rest up for the exciting days ahead!

Friday, May 2, 2025

9:00 AM: Vendor Set-Up

All vendors may begin setting up booths, dealer displays, and demo zones in front of the ski lodge and designated vendor areas.

12:00 PM: Vendors Open

The vendor zone officially opens to the public. Explore snowmobile gear, accessories, and services while engaging directly with local and national brands.

12:00 PM - 5:00 PM: Information Booth & Raffle

Visit the central Info Booth by the snowmobile loading ramp for maps, event questions, and raffle ticket purchases. Raffle prizes will be drawn Saturday night.

A relaxed, guided ride ideal for those newer to mountain riding or looking for an orientation-style loop. Led by experienced riders.

Bring the kids to the lodge for crafts, hot cocoa, and fun. A great opportunity for young snowmobile fans to meet, interact, and get ready for Saturday's rides.
