While serving as Assistant Director (Publications and Examinations) in the Department of Distance Education, University of Kalyani, Faruque Ahamed started his Ph.D. degree in the Department of History at the University of Kalyani in 2016. Faruque Ahamed got Prof. Alok Kumar Ghosh, Head of the department of history, as his supervisor who encouraged him in continuing research on 'The Contribution of Muslim-run Mission Schools in the Post-Independence Period'. His dedication to research won laurels from many other distinguished Professors of Kalyani University. Special mention should be made of Prof. (Dr.) Gautam Pal, former Pro-VC whose constant help was his strength. Prof. (Dr.) Manas Kumar Sanyal Hon'ble former VC


