Building collapsed at Garden Reach, 10 died, many injured



A five-storey under-construction building collapsed in Kolkata's congested Garden Reach area late Sunday night, the entire structure collapsed, with parts of it falling on neighboring homes in the densely populated area. Rescue workers on Tuesday evening recovered the body of another person from underneath the debris of the collapsed five-storey building in Kolkata's Garden Reach area taking the toll to 10. Kolkata Police Commissioner Vineet Goyal and senior officers, along with disaster management teams and fire service officials, had rushed to the spot. Personnel of the state disaster management department, NDRF, fire department and Kolkata Police's disaster management unit resumed rescue operations. Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, visited the spot and said the building was illegally constructed and has asked authorities to take action against those responsible.
