He is survived by wife, a son and three daughters. Last week, Prof. Alquadri's condition deteriorated and was admitted to a nursing home where he breathed his last. The namaz-e-janazah was performed at 22 Taltalla Lane (Khanqah Sharif) and laid to rest at Mednipore. He was awarded Ph. D. degree on his monumental work on Hazrat Amir Khusrau. The president of India has awarded him "The Certificate of Honour" and lifetime monetary support for his outstanding scholarship. He joined the University of Calcutta as a Lecturer in 1966 and subsequently promoted to the post of Reader, Professor and Asutosh Professor of Islamic Culture (Chair Post), Head of the Department of Arabic and Persian and Dean of Faculty of Arts. He also served as the Chairman of Minorities Commission, Government of West Bengal and Ambassador of India to Tashkent (Uzbekistan).






