**Sacrament of the Anointing**

Sacrament of the Anointing is to be administered by a priest. The Sacrament of Anointing can be conferred upon a baptized person who has attained the age of reason and who faces illness, danger, old age, or infirmity. **This sacrament should not be postponed until the person is gravely ill.** Ideally, whenever a person facing illness or infirmity feels the need for strength and blessing of the church they should seek the sacrament within the context of a healing mass. The sacrament can be received more than once and should be received when a person **begins to be in danger due sickness or old age.** The sacrament shouldn't be deferred until death is immanent.

**Funeral Arrangements**

When making Funeral arrangements please go to the mortuary first and the funeral home will contact the office to make final arrangements for the mass and burial.
