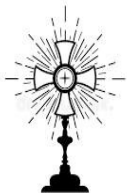
MISSION STATEMENT/DECLARACION DE MISION

Sacrament of the Anointing

The Sacrament of Anointing is to be administered by a priest. The Sacrament can be conferred upon a baptized person who has attained the age of reason and who faces illness, danger, old age, or infirmity. **This sacrament should not be postponed until the person is gravely ill.** Ideally, whenever a person facing illness or infirmity feels the need for strength or blessing of the church they should seek the sacrament within the context of a healing mass. This sacrament can be received more than once and should be received when a person **begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age.** The sacrament shouldn't be de-
