

# Sacrament of the Anointing

The Sacrament of Anointing is to be administered by a priest. The Sacrament can be conferred upon a baptized person who has attained the age of reason and who faces illness, danger, old age, or infirmity. This sacrament should not be postponed until the person is gravely ill. Ideally, whenever a person facing illness or infirmity feels the need for strength or blessing of the church they should seek the sacrament within the context of a healing mass. This sacrament can be received more than once and should be received when a person begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age. The sacrament shouldn't be deferred until death is immanent.
