

The year began with a vibrant "Watchnight" service. Bishop Izett Scott hosted another celebratory night as brethren and friends gathered to talk about God's goodness specifically during the 2024 year.

Later in the month of January, our dearest, Bishop Scott became ill and before his birthday came on February 22, he transitioned.

The viewing service was held on Friday, March 14, at the church. This well attended, and disciplined crowd showed up in solidarity of bereavement with the Scott's family. There was not enough time to talk about Bishop's exuberant contribution to the church community. Everyone seemed to have copied notes, as they repetitiously commended his work, walk, and wisdom. On Saturday, March 15, the grand funeral service was held at Genesis Christian Center 1490 Banks Road, Margate, Florida.

That was excellent! Once again, time was limited but people crammed in just about every commendation that a well-lived human being could have earned. The voices came from as far as Nigeria with 500 persons online, eagerly watching the proceedings.

The 50-member, Izett Scott's Mass choir led by a vibrant and talented Minister from the Pentecostal Assemblies of Jesus, Ft. Lauderdale, stirred the congregants with the well rendered "May The Works, I've Done, Speak For Me."

Bishop Monroe R. Saunders, Jr., D. Min, from Transformation Church, Baltimore, Maryland eulogized the Bishop while admonishing the gathering regarding the importance of family. It was befitting of the man Bishop Scott was. The Lauderdale Lake's city officials were present and made major contributions to the day's program.

Madam Commissioner Hazel Rogers and her team officially pronounced March 15 "Bishop Izett Scott Day" *That, right there,* is indicative of Bishop's amazing involvement in the community. Madam Commissioner Sharon Thomas read an Expression of Sympathy and presented the document in his honor. Other officials of the community, too numerous to mention, spoke highly of our Bishop.



Use of Basic Technology

Today, church operations are, by far, more structured with technology rather than remaining in the boon docks of all manual functions.

FUCJCA observed that as it population increases there will be a need for multiple access to its communication sources. Hence the church communicates its activities to the community by way of OR Code Scan. Although some members were intimidated by the opportunity to digitally spread the word about church wide activities, Sunday worship service program, birthday celebration and other important events, this move has eliminated the regular reading of notices which absorbed much time in the high session of workshop during the Sunday services. OR code SCANS are available at the ushers' desk at the church. A KIOSK for guest enrollment was installed but due to increase ill-perceptions, the church administration held back implementing it until the church members are comfortably educated about its use and benefits.

The new website is located at www.fucjcaftlauderdale.com. This is a great hub for information feed. It accommodates a summary of church activities and gives in details a structure of the church operation. Documents that help to maintain a good church design are uploaded there as well as an archive of our Wednesday night Christian Education study and resource materials.

Thanks to the church's competent Technology team the operation continues to provide an archive of services and other special events.

The radio broadcast at WAVS1170 keeps the word of God live to the hearers. It is hosted by Bishop Everton Walker, the pastor and is available to listeners on internet feed as well.

Currently, the church tech team and other competent members are working on obtaining licensing for producing our own internet radio broadcast. That is exciting! "It is all about reaching the lost at any cost"

The Ancilary Departments

Ancillary departments, are groupings within the main church group. These are departments structured to facilitate the spiritual growth and development of the members of the church. Regular Sunday School

Even though the Children's Church is a work in progress our students have available to them, age- appropriate lessons, fun lesson props, rest time, snack and sing-along session.

Church life-style can be very daunting for a young person. The Sunday School is designed to give young adults the opportunity to be comfortable about bible discussions and lessons geared toward young adult life and spiritual development. Sunday school begins at at 10:00am and ends at 11:30.
