1. **The Word** – Oral tradition and spoken promises
2. **The Oath** – Verbal commitments sanctified by ritual or divine witness
3. **Writing** – Permanent records of language and agreements
4. **Dirt Paths** – Sustained communication and trade between neighboring communities
5. **The Pouch** – Portable container for carrying messages, goods, or symbolic tokens

14. **Fire and Smoke Relay Networks** – Early long-distance visual signaling systems

17. **Semaphore** – Transition signaling system preceding photography
18. **Trains** – High-speed mass movement of messages, mail, and publications
19. **Photography** – Visual documentation of reality and memory
20. **Film** – Sequential visual storytelling and historical recording
21. **Cars** – Personal mobility enabling flexible, fast information delivery
22. **Telegraph** – Long-distance, near-instant written transmission
23. **Morse Code** – Standardized encoding for telegraphic communication
