# Lake Distinction:

#### Eastern Lake

First lake on the right after the main entrance into Callaway Lakes



## <u>Central Lake</u> (or Middle Lake)

(Traveling towards Home Drive from the main entrance) down from the Eastern Lake on the

## Western Lake (largest of the three)

(Traveling towards Home Drive from the main entrance) down from the Central Lake on the left.

#### Lake Guidelines:

- 1. DO NOT fish for bass February 1 through April 15<sup>th</sup>. This will allow time for the current fish to bed down and make plenty of future fish.
- 2. DO NOT introduce any fish to the ponds unless approved by the BOARD. Crappie, white perch, green sunfish are examples of undesirable species.
- 3. DO NOT apply chemicals to the pond unless approved by the BOARD. Not only is Round-Up harmful to the fish population, it is *ILLEGAL* to apply around ponds, streams and lakes without a license.
- 4. **DO** feed the fish often. Ivey's, Tractor Supply, and Bennett Supply offer BB sized floating feed pellets at a reasonable cost.
- 5. If you would like to encourage the fish population, please contact the BOARD for guidance to place a proper structure on your lake.

As for the use of the ponds, please remember that the lots surrounding every pond ARE PRIVATE PROPERTY and should be respected as such. You are trespassing if you are on your neighbor's property without permission. The following are helpful guidelines.

- 1. DO ask permission before fishing from land that is not yours.
- 2. DO carry forceps, pliers or other hook removal tools AT ALL TIMES while fishing.
- 3. DO return the captured fish to the water as quickly as possible.
- 4. Barbless hooks are recommended.
- 5. Boaters must not encroach upon bank fisherman/women. Only trolling motors are allowed.
- 6. DO NOT dive from, climb on, or in any way disrupt the fountains. You may boat around them, but please do not touch.
- 7. Guests may fish from YOUR PROPERTY ONLY. A guest MUST BE accompanied by a member if he/she is fishing from a boat.
- 8. Guests are limited to CATCH and RELEASE ONLY for bass.
- 9. DO NOT attempt to catch or kill the grass carp. If caught accidentally, please release as quickly as possible.
