3. Maintenance Report-Mayor McFarland and Reggie Applin to meet with Maintenance to go over duties. Patresha Northgraves requested the bushes at the Welcome to Historic Kingston sign be cut lower. Stated the park area and restrooms for the event on Saturday, June 27th, was clean and everything was picked up.
