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- (43) Father Pass “some authority” but not all to the Husband-to be. (Duffy, p. 63)
- (44) Direct Counseling for the Father-In-Law: The husband-to-be should seek counseling from his father-in-law on how to address questions of her continued education and or potential employment, family planning, financial management and other areas in which he and the daughter will begin planning.
- (45) Fathers can warn the young man about any imperfections in his daughter (Duffy, p 63)

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(46) What is Love? (1 John 4:8, 18; John 3:16) (Duffy, p.65). Love is an action word that requires one to give of himself, without any regard to or biases to who you are or what you are. Furthermore, if you are in Love with God, he will dwell in you and you will abide in God. Proof that God loves you is demonstrated when he should have cut you off because of your sins and inquiry (absence of spiritual or moral values.) Nevertheless your life could have been ended. However, as a result of repenting of your sins, He forgave you, showed mercy. Now that you understand what love is, let's exploit the two fundamentals of Love, which is Mercy and accountability.

(47) Twenty reasons we should love others:

1. To prove that we are of God (1Jn. 4:7).
2. It proves sonship (1Jn. 4:7; 5:1-2).
3. It is proof of knowing God (1Jn. 4:7-8).
4. Because God is love and we should imitate Him as children of God (1Jn. 4:8,16).
5. God has imparted love to us (1Jn. 4:9; Rom. 5:5).
6. God sent His Son to make it possible (1Jn. 4:9; 1Pet. 2:21).
7. That we might live (1Jn. 4:9,10,14).
8. Because God first loved us (1Jn. 4:10,19).
9. We have been loved and forgiven so much (1Jn. 4:10; Jn. 3:16).
10. It is our duty (1Jn. 4:11).
11. God loved us when we were unlovable (1Jn. 4:11; Rom. 5:6-10).
12. God dwells in us (1Jn. 4:12).
13. God's love is perfected in us (1Jn. 4:12).
14. Because of the indwelling Spirit (1Jn. 4:13).
15. We believe in love (1Jn. 4:16).
16. We dwell in God (1Jn. 4:16).
17. We are like Him (1Jn. 4:17).
18. It proves we love God (1Jn. 4:20).

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19. It is a command (1Jn. 4:21; 5:2).
20. It is natural as sons of God (1Jn. 5:1-2).

(48) Love Mercy and Accountability (Chpt 13)

- (a) Mercy defined - No further consequence of this action. You are restored (Duffy, p 65)
- (b) Mother demonstrates Mercy in the Family
- (c) Accountability - There are consequences you will pay for your actions (Duffy, p 65)
- (d) Father demonstrates accountability in the Family

(49) Husband's Intercession (Duffy, p. 70) (Gen 15:1)

(50) Children that are raised in an environment where there is Mercy and Accountability, knows and understands that there is a cost to everything. (Duffy, p 67)

(51) Husband's Intercession (Duffy, Chpt 1 - p. 69)

(52) Joseph becomes the Shield and a substitute for his Father; Although his father Jacob was old, he stood in the gap and intercede for the Family: Joseph intercede for his brothers, however, Joseph is substituting himself in his father's place for his children. However, God placed Joseph in the position of authority representing his father. (Gen 44:32-34)

(53) Husbands Love your wives: (Duffy, p 69) Eph 5:25-28)

(54) Men must be willing to substitute themselves for their wives and be sacrifices, just like Jesus Christ substituted himself for the church. (Duffy, p 70) Phil 3:10)
