DR. BREAKSTONE BROKE, HE SAYS IN DEBT COURT

Dr. Benjamin Breakstone, acting president and chief surgeon of the West End hospital, yesterday testified that he is without funds when he was brought into the Debtors' court on an attachment obtained by Dr. Fred E. Miller, 3200 Broadway. Dr. Miller holds a \$3,000 judgment against Dr. Breakstone.

Judge Frank Padden wanted to know why Dr. Breakstone didn't pay the \$3,000 and the physician replied that he has no money. The automobile he drives is owned by his wife, who makes all collections for his services, he said. He testified that he never sent a bill for his services.

Dr. Miller bought shares in the West End hospital for \$3,000 under an agreement that Dr. Breakstone would repurchase them in case the purchase was not satisfactory. Judge Padden continued the case until Sept. 10, instructing Dr. Breakstone to bring in his accounts.
