

# ACTOR TO WED WOMAN HE MET IN JAP PRISON

George Breakstone, actor turned news cameraman during the war, was on a detail sent to Karuizawa internment camp north of Yokohama to ferret out Nazi spies reportedly hiding there. The detail didn't find the spies, but Breakstone found himself a fiancee.

Yesterday he was reported to be in Reno, where he will marry Irene Lord, daughter of a wealthy British family.

Breakstone, who played the role of Andy Hardy's chief rival in the early pictures in the series, was, as a news cameraman, one of the first to land in Japan after the capitulation. At the internment camp he found Miss Lord who prior to Pearl Harbor had conducted a business in Japan and was interned on outbreak of hostilities.

The two fell in love. Breakstone returned to the States, and Miss Lord followed. A week ago she arrived in Seattle and Breakstone went there to join her.

The actor and his film partner, York Copeland, will leave for South America later this month to make a documentary picture called "Two Yanks in the Amazon" for PRC.
