

Ex-Grid Star Kills Self

Seymour Breakstone, 27-year-old ex-football star released from the Army three months ago, was found dead of a gunshot wound in the chest last night in the attic of his home at 140 Hard Lane, Lawrence, L. I. A .45-caliber U. S. Army Colt was beside the body. Police listed the death as suicide.

Breakstone played at Lawrence High School and Hofstra College, Hempstead, then saw action on

Okinawa, Saipan and the Marshall Islands.
