For one World War veteran, time stood still during the past 22 years.

Bernie Breakstone, Hollywood American Legionnaire, recently was called upon to play himself in scenes in "Adam Had Four Sons," the Columbia drama starring Ingrid Bergman and Warner Baxter, showing American troops returning from France. Getting out the uniform he wore that day in 1919, Breakstone made an interesting discovery.

It still fit him to a "t." He hadn't changed by an ounce or an inch.

A founder member of Hollywood Post No. 43, Breakstone was one of 65 veterans to take part in the scene. All the others required new uniforms.
