

One of Five Sons Is Wounded In Action In Pacific Area

One of the five sons of Albert Breakstone, 167 New Mallery street, who are in war service, was wounded while in action in New Guinea, and is now hospitalized, his father was informed today in a telegram from the War Department.

The young soldier is Pfc. Bernard Breakstone, who is with the U. S. forces in the South Pacific. The message said he was not seriously hurt. He joined the colors last year. His brothers are: Delbert in the anti-aircraft service, France; Royal, with military police, London; Morton, a member of U. S. Infantry, England; Selig, postal battalion, New York City.

Two of Mr. Breakstone's daughters are in the WAVES. They are Louise, Norfolk, Va., and Adele, Hunter College. The third and last member of the Breakstone family, is Mrs. Hannah Beryl Swartz, whose husband is a soldier and is located in California.
